Necessary documents:

- ID or passport (can't be expired)
- If available, your Belgian residence permit (Annex 15 if you are still in the process of applying) or your rental agreement
- Enrolment certificate

- Rental agreement (signed by all parties and no older than 3 months)
- Enrolment certificate (no older than 3 months)
- Certificate Proof of Solvency/Blocked account (if applicable)
- Annex 15 or 19 if you've already received this
