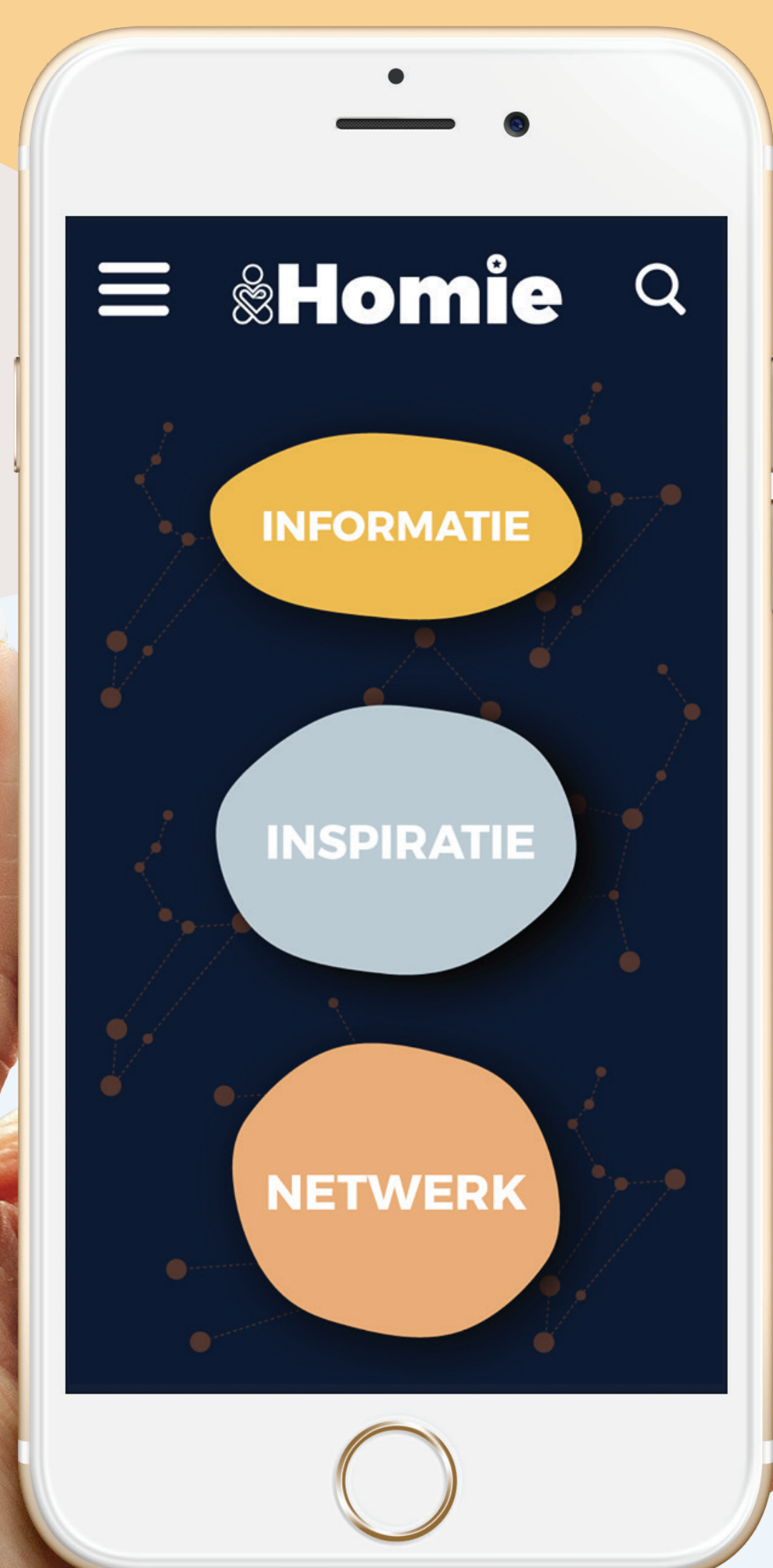
Let the stars guide you through your way home
